## chunky moss stitch mittens

Keep your hands cozy and warm with these chunky mittens. This is a great first mitten project for an adventures beginner and intermediate knitter!

## required skills

Must be comfortable knitting, purling, and knitting in-the-round.

## materials

8o yards of chunky weight yarn
US 11 DPN's
stich markers
tapestry needle

## abbreviations

K - Knit
P - Purl

*     *         - Pattern Repeat

KFB - Knit front and back
SSK - Slip Slip Knit
K2Tog - Knit 2 together

## instructions

## Right Mitten

Cast on 18 stitches and join in the round.

Round 1: *K1, $\mathrm{P}_{1}$ * to end of row
Round 2-8: Repeat Round 1 to create a 1x1 rib cuff
Round 9: K9, ${ }^{*} \mathrm{~K}, \mathrm{P} *$ to end of row
Round 10: K9,*P,K* to end of row

Repeat rows 9-10, two (2) more times.


Round 15: K1, KFB, K7, *K, P* to end of row
Round 16: Kıo, *P, K* to end of row
Round 17: K1, KFB, KFB, K7, *K, P* to end of row.
Round 18: K12, *P, K* to end of row
Round 19: K1, KFB, K2, KFB, K7, *K, P* to end of row.
Round 20: K1, KFB, K4, KFB, K7, *P, K* to end of row.
Round 21: K1, KFB, K14, *K, P* to end of row
Round 22: K1, place next 8 stitches on holder, K8, *P, K* to end of row
Round 23: K9,*K, ${ }^{*}$ * to end of row
Round 24: K9,*P, ${ }^{*}$ to end of row
**Repeat Round 23 and Round 24 until mitten reaches the tip of your pinkie finger**

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## Decrease Rounds

Decrease Round 1: SSK, K5, K2Tog, SSK, *K, P* OR *P, K* for 5 stitches (keep continuity of established pattern), K2Tog

Decrease Round 2: SSK, K3, K2Tog, SSK, *P, K* OR *K, P* for 3 stitches (keep continuity of established pattern), K2Tog

Break yarn leaving a 10 inch tail and graft closed using tapestry needle and Kitchener Stitch.

## Thumb

Move 8 stitches from holder to your double pointed needles.

Pick up 2 stitches where the thumb meets the body of the mitten and knit them together.

Continue to knit (K) all the thumb stitches in the round until desired thumb length.

Break yarn and thread your tail through stitches, pull closed and tie off.

Sew in ends.

## Left Mitten

To start, follow instruction on rounds 1-14 on right mitten.

Round 15: K7, KFB, K1, *K, P* to end of row
Round 16: Kıo, *P, K* to end of row
Round 17: K7, KFB, KFB, K1, *K, $\mathrm{P}^{*}$ to end of row
Round 18: K12, *P, K* to end of row
Round 19: K7, KFB, K2, KFB, K1, *K, P* to end of row
Round 20: K7, KFB, K4, KFB, K1, *P, K* to end of row
Round 21: K14, KFB, K1, *K, P* to end of row Round 22: K8, place next 8 stitches on holder, K1, *P, K* to end of row
Round 23: K9,*K, ${ }^{*}$ * to end of row Round 24: K9,*P, $\mathrm{K}^{*}$ to end of row
**Repeat Round 23 and Round 24 until mitten reaches the tip of your pinkie finger**

Follow Decrease Rounds and Thumb instructions to finish your mitten.
