Cozy Tunisian Cowl

Cozy up with this simple Tunisian crochet cowl! Made using the Tunisian Full Stitch, creating a unique woven look and squishy texture. Wear it long for dramatic flare, or double up for an extra warm and cozy cowl!

required skills

Must be comfortable with basic Tunisian crochet techniques.

materials

Color 1 - 1 skein Woolfolk Luft

Color 2 - 1 skein Woolfolk Luft

Color 3 - 1 skein Woolfolk Luft

(109 yards of bulky weight yarn for each color)

US L (8mm) Tunisian Hook - 9" straight or shortest cord available.

gauge

11 st x 12 rows = 4"

abbreviations

TFS - Tunisian Full Stitch

st(s) - stitch(es)



notes

- For the Tunisian Full Stitch (TFS), always insert the hook from front to back through the spaces between vertical pairs of strands.
- At the end of every Forward Pass, create an End stitch by inserting the hook into the three vertical strands with two of the strands to the left of the hook and one strand to the right of the hook, yo, pull up a loop.

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instructions

foundation row

Start with color 1.

Forward Pass: Ch 25. Insert the hook into the 2nd ch from the hook, yo, pull up a loop (2 loops on hook). [Insert hook in the next ch, yo, pull up loop] across the ch.

Return Pass: Ch 1. [yo, pull through 2 loops] until 1 loop remains on the hook.

tunisian full stitch

ROW 1

Forward Pass: Insert hook in the first space between the right edge and the next vertical pair of strands, yo, pull up loop. [Insert hook in the next space, yo, pull up a loop] across the row until the next to the last space. Make the End stitch.

Return Pass: Ch 1. [yo, pull through 2 loops] until 1 loop remains on the hook.

ROW 2

Forward Pass: Insert hook in the 2nd space from the right edge, yo, pull up a loop. [Insert hook in the next space, yo, pull up loop] across the row, including the last space. Make the End stitch.

Return Pass: Ch 1. [yo, pull through 2 loops] until 1 loop remains on the hook.

Repeat Row 1 and Row 2 for 15 inches. On the last Return Pass, leave 2 loops on the hook to transition colors.

Do not cut color 1.

color transition

With 2 loops left on the hook at the end of your last Return Pass, yo with color 2 yarn and pull through the 2 loops.

Complete **Row 1** of the TFS with color 2, leaving the last 2 loops on the Return Pass on the hook. With color 1, yo, pull through the 2 loops.

Complete **Row 2** of the TFS with color 1, leaving the last 2 loops on the Return Pass on the hook. With color 2, yo, pull through the 2 loops.

Repeat last 2 steps another 4 times.

Cut color 1.

color 2

Continue with color 2 in the TFS for 15 inches. On the last Return Pass, leave 2 loops on the hook to transition colors.

Do not cut color 2.

repeat color transition

Repeat Color Transition section, this time between color 2 and color 3 for a total of 6 repeats.

color 3

Continue with color 3 in the TFS for 15 inches. On the last Return Pass, leave 2 loops on the hook to transition colors.

Do not cut color 3.

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repeat color transition

Using the remaining amount you have of color 1, repeat color transition instructions for a total of 6 times (if you do not have enough to finish the repeats, do as many as you can, leaving enough yarn to do a bind off with color 3)

bind off

We bind off on the forward pass, using color 3. Insert hook into the appropriate "first" space (if Row 1 = 1st space from right edge; if Row 2 = 2nd space from the right edge), yo, pull up loop, yo, pull through both loops. [Insert hook into the next space, yo, pull through both loops on hook] across to the end of the row.

joining the ends into a cowl

Hold the two ends of the cowl together, TFS front sides facing each other. With color 3, single crochet the 2 ends together.
