

# Granny Head Wrap

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This easy and cute head wrap uses the granny stitch for a quick project!

## required skills

Must be comfortable with the common crochet stitches.

## materials

DK weight yarn  
US H / 5mm hook  
Tapestry needle

## abbreviations

ch - chain  
ch space - see notes  
dc - double crochet  
granny cluster - a group of 3 double crochet stitches.  
st(s) - stitch(es)

## Notes

- Instructions in-between asterisks \*-\*, indicate a repeat.
- To “crochet into chain space”, place your hook under the chain stitch in between the granny cluster to create your stitches. Do not try to stitch into the chain stitch.



## instructions

### Wrap

Row 1: Ch 4, 2dc into first chain made, turn (1 granny cluster)

Row 2: Ch 3, dc into first st, ch 1, 2dc into third ch of turning st, turn

Row 3: Ch 3, dc into first st, ch 1, 3 dc into ch space, ch 1, 2 dc into last st, turn

Row 4: Ch 3, dc into first st, ch 1, \*3dc into ch space, c1,\* repeat into all ch spaces, 2dc in last st, turn

Repeat Row 4 until large enough to fit around your head.

### Ties

On the corners of the longest edge, chain stitch a cord until your ties are at least 10 in long. Knot the end and cut your yarn.
